After many weeks of fevers, diarrhea, and intense pain, Billy was diagnosed with Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia. Instead of him being able to do what normal healthy 2 year olds do, Billy's life consists of Chemotherapy treatments through his port, oral medication, shot injections, infusions, hospitalizations and painful procedures.
