What is PKU? Phenylketonuria is a rare inherited metabolic disorder in which infants born untreated may develop mental retardation and neurological disorder. Currently, the only treatment is for individuals to adhere to a strict, low protein diet, consisting of fruits and vegetables and special low protein medical foods. All the food eaten by a person with PKU should be weighed and monitored to ensure that the PHE levels are within the appropriate range. Individuals with PKU must also have their PHE levels monitored with blood test, drink supplementing formula and meet with Dr.'s and dieticians, their entire lives. **Money from this run will buy care packages for families at Children's Hospital who just found out their child has this PKU disorder. These families are often totally unaware of this disorder and extremely confused and distraught. This care package will provide these families with the tools they need to begin this diet.**
